- New Scoreboards for the Gym
 - o Jim Okler presented a proposal for new scoreboards for the gym. The old scoreboards would be moved to the middle school. This proposal is not included in the bond fund and he is requesting support from the Athletic Booster Club similar to how we paid for the tennis courts (ie; set amount allocated over a 3-4 year period)

She has attended numerous Booster Club meetings since she was first introduced to the club during the August 2003 meeting.
- o Dave Giles explained the Hoops Night Checks that have been arriving during the winter basketball season
 - Dave in an effort to build support, improve attendance, and make the Girl's Varsity games a fun event, solicited sponsors to provide funding for half time events such as half court shots, tee shirt give aways, etc. The checks that the booster club received will be used to reimburse some of the expenses the "Hoops Night" organizers incurred.
- o Lacrosse team presentation
 - Mr. Ryan the lacrosse team coach talked to the club and is requesting approximately \$900.00 to help defray the cost of ground maintenance and field repair of the Lacrosse Field.
 - 39 players tried out this year.

 - The request can be brought to the board at April's meeting for a vote.
